Principal's report

- Today (Oct 3) field trip to grade 5/6 soccer game @ Ward's Island Field
- Terry Fox run was a success for children of all ability levels, \$610 raised directly through the Terry Fox Foundation website by parents, staff and students, see our results at https://schools.terryfox.ca/41221
- National Day for Truth and Reconciliation (Saturday) activities last week in classrooms, school-wide assembly On Fri Sep 29
- Curriculum night Thu Oct 5 4:00-5:15pm, 4:15 meet in gym to start
 - Gary will welcome all parents & introduce School Council members (16 parent reps + execs)
 - School Council can address community
 - Remind parents to get police reference checks so they can be involved in school activities e.g. volunteering
 - If already have a police reference check with the school need to do an offense declaration yearly to keep it valid
 - Cori manages this, Samira or designate to approach Cori to learn how people can complete their declarations so new police reference checks aren't required yearly
 - Lindsay organizing parent engagement input
 - Gary suggests by entrance, staff room, before gym so get maximum exposure
- School did not need to reorganize classes this year, but did have to reassign two teachers since had difficulty recruiting a part time French teacher
 - o Reassigned French-capable teacher accordingly and back-filled with land education teacher
- Still looking for part-time music teacher
- Gary working on getting teaching & non-teaching School Council representatives, he has communicated with them, staff need to choose from among themselves

School Council communication

- School Council can create mailing lists from its TDSB-provided address
- Leverages School Messenger: execs will get access to the web app & authorization, pre-populated with distribution lists for whom you want to communicate with: parents, students, office staff, etc.
- Gary will have this sent out & provide training

Treasurer report - Jen Yeung

- We have no money with TDSB
- Lighthouse foundation has own bank account but we don't have access, no hand-off from last year's School Council
- TDSB doesn't know The Lighthouse Foundation transactions, only transactions that go through the school
 - o E.g. cheesecake, ice cream truck
- TDSB doesn't have a clear picture of what was done, only transactions that went through School Cash Online
- Info shared was redacted as necessary to protect personal information e.g. if a cheque went to/came from a person
- Jen to follow up on unclear spending (ice cream truck, 2021-2 donation items that were funded)
- SUBSEQUENT ADDITION: Principal's note: School Council is to use KEV Group's School Cash Online and the TDSB's bank provider (Alterna) if necessary for School Council financial activities
