- Decided: regular monthly working meetings for School Council
- Possibly 1st Tuesday every month, virtual, 6:30-7:30
- Samira confirm w/ Gary it's okay for various teachers show up
- To save time, Gary only has to present principal's report at the 4 necessary meetings
- Abi & Samira to determine which are the 3 more "big" meetings everyone should attend, and which
 ones will be in person (likely earlier start than 6:30)
- Abi & Samira determine Jan 2->9 and any other changes
- Jun 4th last meeting

Fundraising plans

- Give \$/teacher for them to spend: **9 classrooms**, if \$200/teacher = \$1800

 - 8. Grade 5 Room 105 Borges
 - 9. Grade 6 Room 106 Castro-Guerra
- Top item requests: fun fair, Halloween event, spirit wear
 - A little too soon to do Halloween event
- Have ~\$1400 from community fun fair event (is community-raised funds, not TDSB/IPS SC)
- Can we buy computers? Not clear we can/can't, but has been done many times before, and through TDSB procurement process
 - Can we pay for the nutrition program and repurpose those \$ for other things?
- Are the Chromebooks leased & up for renewal vs. owned? Many are owned & purchased by School Council, but what about the rest?
 - o Abi to research renting vs. owning, talk to Miss Lana
 - Will put this as a fundraising item if we're allowed
- One parent suggested enhanced playground
 - Kate to contact Sonia @ Gibraltar re: playground for Gibraltar & JK
 - Be mindful of distributing funds across all groups
- Are supposed to spend funds raised that year, or by following year; can hold funds in reserve for longer if fundraising for a larger item e.g. playground
- Proposal:
 - 1st priority = teacher fund
 - o 2nd priority = computers
 - o 3rd priority = playground
- Also provide misc. meals & snacks at events e.g. curriculum night, track & field
- Staff appreciation potluck supplied by parents (activity but not fundraising)

- Ask parents to donate upfront? Parents can donate to get us started, even directly via School Cash Online https://tdsb.schoolcashonline.com/Fee/Details/457/153/false/true
 - o Probably won't go over well with parents, and we don't have credibility yet
 - But some parents don't like to be badgered for money and would prefer to give upfront once rather than be asked repeatedly
- Halloween event @ WIA
 - Simple? Warming station w/ music
 - o Can do decorations & haunted house
 - o Kids won't want to sit at the WIA, will want to run around and get a ton of candy ASAP
 - o Parents might like it
 - Keep it simple, give out candy, have hot drinks
 - Can we sell alcohol? Not on TDSB property
 - Is a big increase in convenience if families can pick up kids @ WIA and have food provided
 - o Jeff to organize Halloween event sub-committee

TDSB policy notes on alcohol

- Jason subsequent research added to meeting notes no current policy re: off-premises events?
- Restrictions on Alcohol, Drug and Tobacco Use Policy (P095): https://ppf.tdsb.on.ca/uploads/files/live/98/2086.pdf
 - 6.3 Alcohol may be served on Board premises by permit holders for school sponsored events only, subject to the approval of the Director of Education or designate. (Source: Community Use of Board Facilities (Permits) Policy - P011)
 - Later points reinforce that alcohol can't be promoted or sold or consumed during Board-related functions, Board will not support any events that relates to the consumption or sale of alcohol

 - 6.11.1. TDSB fundraising activities must not promote or allow the sale and/or consumption of alcohol, drug or tobacco as per the Restrictions on Alcohol, Drug and Tobacco Use Policy (P095).

Spirit wear

- Jen leading, Abi will help, Tracey will help, too
- 2 companies we can order from
- Jen to get samples
- T-shirts, hoodies, baseball caps, toques
 - Student design competition!
 - Do for next year since have more time to start
 - o People unlikely to buy the same shirt every year, but might buy more if are different logos
- Do hoodie & toque now, then baseball cap & t-shirt for summer?
 - But might make people not buy until new logo is done
- Also do fundraising with Mabel's Labels to make it easier to tell apart identical clothing!
 - They give us ~10% of what's ordered through our school link
 - Jen look into Mabel's Labels funding, get our link so we can publish it
- Gary: school will pay for a shirt for all students?
 - o Then can have a spirit wear day and everyone has a shirt, is good community building
 - School has backup shirts for kids that don't have spirit wear when they go to sporting events
 - o Approach Gary after we've confirmed prices, does he have budget for all 200 students?
- t shirts printed 2 sides \$10 adults or \$8 kids, e.g. \$15/each so can be a good fundraiser
 - This doesn't exclude people from participating so is a good choice for fundraising
 - \$20/shirt is pretty standard, and if it only costs us \$10 is a good opportunity to fundraise

 - Snack \$20/month, lunch/month \$130 (~\$6.50-7.00/day)
 - Pancake breakfast?
 - Want to look into nutritional aspects of the program and other snacks/candy being given out
